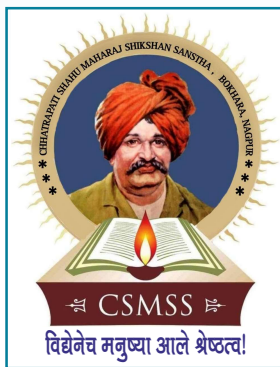

## Brief History of the Sanstha

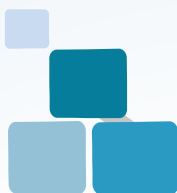

## Rules for Admission

- (1) Student seeking admission to the college should fill the admission form correctly giving his/her all details. The student and parents must sign the declaration/undertaking in the prescribed application form for admission.
- (2) The application form should be attached the following important documents.
  - (i) Original leaving certificate (TC) of last school / college attended. (ii) Original mark sheet of last qualifying examination of SSC/HSSC/any other exa. (iii) Caste certificate for students belonging to SC/ST category and Non-creamy layer certificate for OBC/VJ-NT/SBC students. (iv) Domicile certificate, Ration card, Bank pass book and Aadhar card. (v) Two latest passport size photographs. (vi) Migration certificate and Eligibility certificate (In case of a student from outside. exam board other than Maharashtra or outside university other than R.T.M. Nagpur University. and gap certificate if needed.
- (3) Student must fill up and submit the following forms immediately after his/her admission.
  - (i) Enrollment form with original marksheet of XIIth class. (ii) Scholarship form / Freeship form / Rajshree Chhatrapati Shahu Maharaj Scholarship form
  - (iii) Examination forms twice a year - two semesters.
- (4) The prescribed admission fees must be paid sincerely. The admission fees once paid, will not be refunded under any circumstances if the admission is cancelled on student's behalf. If a student doesnot attend the

## Scholarship/Freeship-GOI Facility

- 1) Students belonging to category of SC/ST/OBC/VJ-NT/SEBC must fill up online scholarship / Freeship forms and submit its hardcopy in college immediately after the admission.
- 2) Rajshree Chhatrapati Shahu Maharaj Scholarship form should be filled up online and submitted its hard copy by the students belonging to open category and Muslim, Shikh, Buddha, Christian, Jain & other minorities students.
- 3) The following documents must be submitted with scholarship form.
  - i) Original Income Certificate (ii) Caste certificate for SC/ST students and Creamy Layer with Caste Certificate for OBC/VJ-NT/SBC students.
  - (iii) Domicile Certificate and Ration card. (The student will not be entitled for scholarship if he/she is third child of parents). (iv) Pass book/Account Number of Nationalised bank or Post Office Account (**students own mobile number should be linked to the account number**). (v) Adhar Card (**Students own mobile number must be linked with adhar.**) and Gap Certificate if needed. (vi) T.C./Marksheet of X & XII and sem passed.

## Code of conduct for Students

- (1) Respectful and orderly behaviour with Principal Teachers, Non Teaching staff and fellowmate, is highly expected on part of each student.
- (2) Students must attend regular classes, practicals, extra curricular activities including class, seminar, guest lecture by expert faculty. 75% attendance is essential for appearing in examinations.
- (3) Every student must wear Identity card and college uniform in the premises of the college.
- (4) Every student should appear in college Unit test, Annual college test examination and submit the college assignment and to attend medical physical test conducted by college.
